Advanced clinical practitioners (ACPs) are highly trained professionals with the knowledge and skills to take on wider roles caring for patients. ACPs are healthcare professionals, educated to Master's level or equivalent, with the skills and knowledge to allow them to expand their scope of practice to better meet the needs of the people they care for.

What do ACPs do?

ACPs can manage your care in partnership with you and your carers. They'll listen to your concerns and in partnership with you, make decisions on the next steps to make sure you get the care you need. They can prescribe some drugs, order tests, organise treatment and work out the best treatment plan with you.

PHARMACY FIRST SERVICE

Once you have completed a Patchs request detailing your symptoms the doctor may refer to our "Pharmacy First Service" if you meet the criteria below:

- Acute ear infection (1 to 17 years)
- Impetigo (1 year and over)
- Infected insect bites (1 year and over)
- Shingles (18 years and over)
- Sinusitis (12 years and over)
- Sore throat (5 years and over)
- Uncomplicated urinary tract infections (women 16-64 year)
